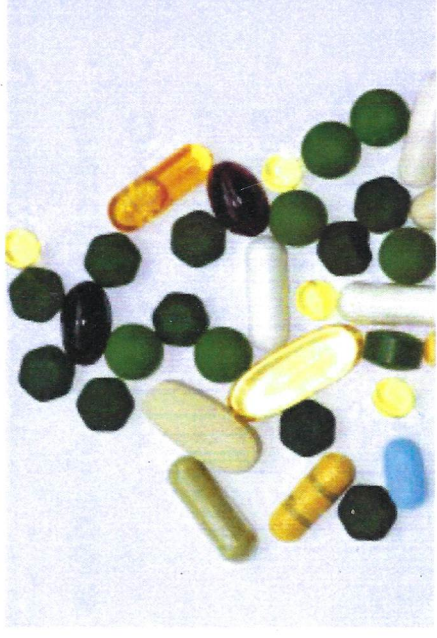

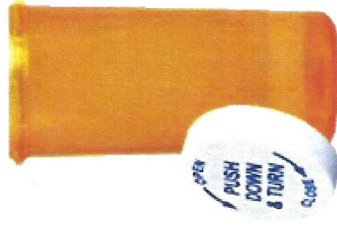

## DISCARD:

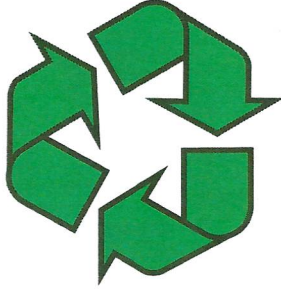
- all plastic caps in the garbage
